## **Our Policy**

Pathfinder Services Inc. uses its best effort to respect the privacy of its online visitors. In general, when you visit our Website and access information, you remain anonymous. This means that at our site, we do not collect personally identifiable information from individuals unless they provide it to us voluntarily and knowingly. This means we do not require you to register or provide information to us in order to view our site. Pathfinder Services Inc. only gathers personally identifiable data, such as names, addresses, zip/postal codes, e-mail address, etc., when voluntarily submitted by a visitor. For example, personally identifiable information may be collected in order to respond to a stated desire to volunteer time, request more information about the services of Pathfinder Services Inc., or request to be contacted by Pathfinder Services Inc.

## **How Does Pathfinder Services Inc. use “Cookies”?**

Visitors should be aware that non-personal information and data may be automatically collected by the Pathfinder Services Inc. Website through the use of “cookies”. “Cookies” are small text files a Website can use to recognize repeat visitors, facilitate the visitors’ ongoing access to and use of the site, and allow a site to track usage behavior and compile aggregate data that will allow content improvements. Cookies are not programs that come onto a visitor’s system and damage files. Generally, cookies work by assigning a unique number to the visitor that has no meaning outside the assigning site. If a visitor does not want information collected through the use of cookies, there is a simple procedure in most browsers that allows the visitor to deny or accept the cookie feature. Pathfinder Services Inc. uses “cookie” technology only to obtain non-personal information from its online visitors in order to improve the visitors’ online experience and facilitate their visit within our site.
